# **Unique Partnerships:**

#### Subaru Share the Love Program:

#### **ArtsWave**

Most Valuable Kids received a grant from Artswave to implement a one-day summer program to introduce the arts to 83 kids from 6 recipient agencies located in the Place Matters Neighborhoods. MVK, The Cincinnati Arts Association and the Society of the Preservation of Music Hall worked together to get kids "in the doors," the majority who have not previously been exposed to cultural arts opportunities in our community. The kids visited the Aronoff Center, the Weston Art Gallery and Music Hall. The program gave kids a "behind-the-scenes" experience at these venues while also learning about potential career choices beyond the frontline performers.
